Dear Mr. Alvarez: As the author of SB 249, which makes permanent the Off-Highway Motorized Vehicle Recreation Program, I am submitting this letter to the Senate Journal to clarify my preference with regard to Section 6 of the measure, outline some of the outstanding issues related to the program, and express my commitment to continue working with the Administration and all stakeholders in securing responsible off-road recreation opportunities in California.

Section 6 amends Section 5090.15 of the Public Resources Code. This section relates to the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Commission within the Department of Parks and Recreation and specifies the composition of those appointed. SB 249 sunsets the Commission on January 1, 2023 and calls on the Department to convene a stakeholder process to make recommendations to the Governor and the Legislature regarding implementation of Section 5090.15.

It is my preference that, as part of this stakeholder process, the Department will explore ways to achieve better diversity of experience and expertise of those serving on the Commission, and, as appropriate, consider other opportunities that allow for robust consideration of the public's interest and needs, and offer opportunities for public participation in the program. It is my strong belief that the Commission, or any other public forum related to off-highway recreation, would benefit from the involvement of public health experts. It is further my preference that, upon



receiving the recommendations resulting from this stakeholder process, and prior to the sunset of the Commission, the Legislature will act upon the recommendations.

Throughout the legislative process, we convened numerous stakeholder meetings to discuss SB 249 and the OHV Program generally. During these meetings, both the environmental community and the OHV advocates raised a suite of issues, though both groups agreed with the goal of balancing recreational opportunities with the protection of natural and cultural resources. SB 249 was able to address some of these concerns but several issues were left unresolved.

Although SB 249 removes the sunset on the OHV Program, I acknowledge that the work is not done. It is my understanding, following extensive conversations with the Department, that the Department intends to convene additional stakeholder initiatives to continue exploring solutions to and better understanding of some of the outstanding issues and conflicts that exist surrounding this program. I support these efforts and look forward to participating, as appropriate, in them. I encourage my colleagues to do likewise.
