**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES**

The following measures were introduced, read the first time, and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

**Senate Bill 1003:** By Senator Roth—An act to amend Section 3704 of, and to add Section 3702.5 to, the Business and Professions Code, relating to healing arts.

**Senate Bill 1004:** By Senators Wiener and Moorlach (Principal coauthor: Assembly Member Mullin) (Coauthor: Senator Portantino) (Coauthors: Assembly Members Arambula, Chiu, Eggman, and Mayes)—An act to add Section 5840.4 to the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to mental health.

**Senate Bill 1005:** By Senator Atkins (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Glazer, and Newman) (Coauthors: Assembly Members Bloom, Chávez, Chiu, Lackey, Maienschein, Quirk, Santiago, Steinorth, and Waldron)—An act to amend Section 13957 of the Government Code, relating to crime victims, and making an appropriation therefor.



**Senate Bill 1006:** By Senator Morrell—An act to amend Section 100036 of the Government Code, relating to private retirement savings.

**Senate Bill 1007:** By Senator Hertzberg—An act relating to financial services.

**Senate Bill 1008:** By Senator Skinner—An act to amend Section 1367.004 of the Health and Safety Code, and to amend Section 10112.26 of the Insurance Code, relating to dental services.

**Senate Bill 1009:** By Senator Wilk (Coauthor: Assembly Member Lackey)—An act to amend Section 84757 of the Education Code, relating to community colleges.

**Senate Bill 1010:** By Senator Beall (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Hertzberg, Hill, Moorlach, Nielsen, Portantino, Stern, and Wiener) (Coauthors: Assembly Members Chiu, Chu, Gipson, Mullin, and Waldron)—An act to amend Sections 2985.1, 2985.3, 2985.4, and 2985.5 of, and to repeal and add Section 2985.2 of, the Penal Code, relating to parole.

**Senate Bill 1011:** By Senator Roth—An act to add Section 1821.5 to the Probate Code, relating to conservatorships.

**Senate Bill 1012:** By Senator Hertzberg—An act to amend Section 85 of the Code of Civil Procedure, relating to courts.

**Senate Bill 1013:** By Senator Lara—An act to add Section 39734 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to greenhouse gases.

**Senate Bill 1014:** By Senator Skinner—An act to add Section 44274.2 to the Health and Safety Code, and to amend Section 5431 of, and to add Section 5450 to, the Public Utilities Code, relating to vehicles.

**Senate Joint Resolution 19:** By Senator Wilk (Coauthor: Assembly Member Mathis)—Relative to special education funding.

**Senate Resolution 81:** By Senator Mitchell—Relative to Women and Girls in Science Day in California.
