**UNANIMOUS CONSENT TO PRINT IN JOURNAL**

Senator McGuire asked for, and was granted, unanimous consent that the following letter be printed in the Journal:

August 29, 2018

*Mr. Daniel Alvarez,*

*Secretary of the Senate*

Dear Mr. Alvarez: I have authored SB 1416, which helps to prevent unsafe conditions by encouraging property owners to take care of dangerous nuisances on their property. I submit this letter to the Senate Journal for the purposes of clarifying the intent of SB 1416.

Sections 25845 (j), 38773.1 (d), and 38773.5 (f) are not intended to limit the existing authority of cities to levy administrative fines. For example, in Section 245845 (j), the word “imposition” is meant to only address the collection mechanism expanded by the bill. In addition, inconsistencies in the drafting between Sections 25845 (l), 38773.1 (f), and 38773.5 (h) seem to imply that the collection mechanism is only limited to those violations that pose an immediate risk to health and safety, instead of all health and safety violations. Again, these drafting errors are not intended to limit the existing authority of cities to levy administrative fines.

Should this legislation be signed into law, it is the intent of the Senate Committee on Governance and Finance to clarify this language next year to harmonize the conflicting sections.
