UNANIMOUS CONSENT TO PRINT IN JOURNAL

Dear Mr. Alvarez: I am submitting this letter to the Senate Daily Journal to clarify my intent regarding SB 1339 (Chapter 566, Statutes of 2018, an act to add Chapter 4.5 (commencing with Section 8370) to Division 4.1 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to electricity. The intent of the legislation is to require that California utilities establish standards for microgrid installations, as defined, that facilitate their commercialization in the state.

As the Legislature has found, California electric customers are seeing benefits from the development of microgrids and microgrid components, including ensuring their own level of reliability and better managing their own usage. The challenge now is to enable microgrids to progress from a promising emerging technology solution to a successful, cost-effective, safe, and reliable commercial product that helps California meet its future energy goals and provides end-use electricity customers new ways to address and manage their individual energy needs. SB 1339 directs a number of actions in support of microgrid deployment. Its fundamental purpose is to reduce barriers to the interconnection of microgrid components, streamline microgrid interconnection, and promote microgrid deployment as a matter of California state law. The bill requires that both investor and publicly-owned utilities take necessary steps to facilitate the installation of microgrids, including standardizing terms and conditions that enable microgrid interconnections and encourage microgrid deployment. The legislation and actions undertaken in response to its enactment should be construed broadly to meet this intent.
