INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced, read the first time, and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

Senate Bill 149: By Senators McGuire and Wiener (Coauthor: Senator Leyva)—An act to amend Sections 6901, 8304, and 8651 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

Senate Bill 150: By Senator Allen—An act to amend Section 11222 of the Vehicle Code, relating to traffic violator schools.

Senate Bill 151: By Senator Nguyen—An act to amend Sections 16180, 16182, 16183, 16184, 16186.5, 16200, 16202, and 27282 of the Government Code, and to amend Sections 2505, 2514, 2515, 2781, 20503, 20505, 20583, 20585, 20586, 20621, 20627, 20630, 20640.3, 20641, 20645.5, and 20645.6 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

Senate Bill 152: By Senator Hernandez (Coauthor: Assembly Member Wood)—An act to amend Section 14102.5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to Medi-Cal.

Senate Bill 153: By Senator Anderson—An act to amend Sections 21380, 21384, 21386, and 21392 of the Probate Code, relating to estates and trusts.

Senate Bill 154: By Senator Anderson—An act to amend Section 2263 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

Senate Bill 155: By Senator Anderson—An act to amend Section 1202.8 of the Penal Code, relating to probation.

Senate Bill 156: By Senator Anderson—An act to amend Section 90 of the Military and Veterans Code, relating to veterans.

Senate Bill 157: By Senator Wieckowski—An act to amend Section 1708.85 of the Civil Code, relating to privacy.

Senate Constitutional Amendment 2: By Senator Newman—A resolution to propose to the people of the State of California an amendment to the Constitution of the State, by amending Sections 1, 5, and 6 of Article XIX thereof, and by amending Section 1 of Article XIX A thereof, relating to transportation.
