INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

Senate Bill 859: By Senator Wiener (Principal coauthors: Assembly Members Chiu and Gloria) (Coauthor: Senator Hurtado) (Coauthor: Assembly Member Bonta)—An act to add Part 3.5 (commencing with Section 120760) to Division 105 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to public health.

Senate Bill 860: By Senator Beall (Coauthors: Senators Durazo, Glazer, Pan, Wiener, and Wilk) (Coauthors: Assembly Members Gipson and Smith)—An act to amend Sections 42921 and 42923 of the Education Code, relating to foster youth.



Senate Bill 861: By Senator Nielsen—An act to amend Section 451 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities.

Senate Bill 862: By Senator Dodd—An act to amend Section 8557 of the Government Code, and to amend Section 8386 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities.
