INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced, read the first time, and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

Senate Bill 65: By Senator Pan—An act to add Section 100503.5 to the Government Code, relating to healthcare coverage.

Senate Bill 66: By Senators Atkins and McGuire—An act to amend Section 14132.100 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to Medi-Cal.

Senate Bill 67: By Senator McGuire (Coauthor: Assembly Member Wood)—An act to add Section 12012.100 to the Government Code, relating to tribal gaming, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
