Senate Bill 176: By Senator Bates (Coauthors: Senators Nguyen and Stone) (Coauthor: Assembly Member Brough)—An act to amend Section 6929 of the Family Code, and to amend Sections 11055, 11370.4, 11372, and 11839.2 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to controlled substances.

Senate Bill 177: By Senator Nguyen—An act to amend Section 4364.5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to mental health, and making an appropriation therefor.

Senate Bill 178: By Senator Wieckowski—An act to amend Section 3479 of the Civil Code, relating to civil law.



Senate Bill 179: By Senator Atkins (Principal coauthors: Senators De León, Galgiani, Monning, Skinner, and Wiener) (Principal coauthors: Assembly Members Gloria, Low, and Mark Stone)—An act to amend Sections 1277 and 1278 of the Code of Civil Procedure, to amend Sections 103425, 103426, 103430, 103435, and 103440 of, and to amend the heading of Article 7 (commencing with Section 103425) of Chapter 11 of Part 1 of Division 102 of, the Health and Safety Code, and to amend Sections 12811 and 13005 of the Vehicle Code, relating to gender identity.

Senate Bill 180: By Senators Mitchell and Lara (Coauthors: Senators Bradford, Skinner, Wieckowski, and Wiener)—An act to amend Section 11370.2 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to controlled substances.

Senate Bill 181: By Senator Berryhill—An act to amend Section 8588 of the Government Code, relating to emergency services.

Senate Bill 182: By Senator Bradford—An act relating to business.

Senate Bill 183: By Senator Lara—An act to add Section 2864 to the Fish and Game Code, and to add Section 5097.992 to the Public Resources Code, relating to marine resources.
