The following measures were introduced, read the first time, and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

Senate Bill 205: By the Committee on Governance and Finance (Senators McGuire (Chair), Beall, Hernandez, Hertzberg, Lara, Moorlach, and Nguyen)—An act to amend Sections 1360 and 25536.9 of the Government Code, relating to local government.

Senate Bill 214: By Senator Atkins—An act to amend Sections 32632, 32633, 32634, 32639, 32643, 32645, 32649, and 32651 of the Public Resources Code, relating to the San Diego River Conservancy.

Senate Bill 215: By Senator Beall—An act to add Section 2605 to the Penal Code, relating to inmates.

Senate Bill 216: By Senator Moorlach—An act to amend Section 656 of the Civil Code, relating to property.

Senate Bill 217: By Senator Wieckowski—An act to amend Section 1120 of the Evidence Code, relating to evidence.

Senate Bill 218: By Senator Dodd—An act to add Section 4885 to the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to the Qualified ABLE Program.

Senate Bill 219: By Senator Wiener (Principal coauthor: Senator Galgiani) (Principal coauthor: Assembly Member Chiu) (Coauthor: Assembly Member Cervantes)—An act to add Chapter 2.45 (commencing with Section 1439.50) to Division 2 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to health facilities.
