Dear Mr. Alvarez: The Legislature recently passed Senate Bill 29, which I authored during the 2017 regular session of the California Legislature in order to stop the further expansion of for-profit immigration detention and create greater transparency with regard to the facilities currently operating in California.

I submit this letter to the Senate Journal for the purpose of clarifying the intent of this measure. Nothing in this measure is intended to conflict with any provisions of Chapter 17, Statutes of 2017 (Assembly Bill 103) which, among other things, added authority for the Judicial Council to transfer a court facility to the County of San Diego. Specifically this bill does not interfere in any way with the authority of the Judicial Council to transfer land to the county of San Diego as added in Article 9 (commencing with Section 70500) of the Government Code. Nor does it interfere with any authority granted to the county in Article 9 (commencing with Section 70500) of the Government Code, as added by provisions of Chapter 17, Statutes of 2017 (Assembly Bill 103), including, but not limited to, planned use or related contracts.

Additionally, nothing in Senate Bill 29 is intended to delay the effective date of the moratorium enacted by AB 103 which prohibited city and county jails from entering into new contracts, or expanding the capacity of existing contracts in effect as of June 15, 2017, with the federal government for civil immigration purposes.

Dear Mr. Alvarez: I authored Senate Bill 189, which modifies the eligibility for owners of businesses who are also employees of those businesses, to allow members of a company's board of directors to voluntarily opt out of the law's mandate that all employees be covered by workers' compensation protections. I authored SB 189 in response to AB 2883 (Chapter 205, Statutes of 2016), which also modified the eligibility for owners of businesses who are also employees of those businesses to voluntarily waive workers' compensation protections.

After AB 2883 was passed, issues arose over the implementation of the bill. Although not the intent of the author, the bill was interpreted to apply all policies, including existing policies, effective January 1, 2017. This interpretation by the California Department of Insurance resulted in significant implementation issues for insurance companies and many of California's small businesses.

SB 189 contains language establishing an implementation date of July 1, 2018 for several provisions in the bill. Specifically, Labor Code Section 3352, which is added to the Labor Code and is effective on July 1, 2018, contains the following language:

*(b)(2) A policy or contract that is entered into or renewed in compliance with this section is subject to this section as it read on the date that the policy or contract was entered into or renewed.*

This language means that the new provisions apply to all policies incepting or renewing on or after July 1, 2018. This also means the new provisions do not apply to in-force policies. This will ensure that California's insurance companies will have sufficient time to implement the provisions of SB 189 and ensure that California's small businesses have appropriate workers' compensation coverage.

Thank you for the opportunity to clarify these key provisions of SB 189.
