**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES**

The following measures were introduced, read the first time, and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

**Senate Bill 959:** By Senator Beall—An act to add Section 2715 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to water corporations.

**Senate Bill 960:** By Senator Leyva—An act to add Section 2064.1 to the Penal Code, relating to corrections.

**Senate Bill 961:** By Senator Allen—An act to amend Section 8574.7 of the Government Code, relating to oil spills.

**Senate Bill 962:** By Senator Allen—An act to amend Section 9094.5 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

**Senate Bill 963:** By Senator Allen—An act to amend Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to state highways.

**Senate Bill 964:** By Senator Allen—An act to amend Section 84602.3 of the Government Code, relating to the Political Reform Act of 1974.

**Senate Bill 965:** By Senator McGuire—An act to amend Section 284 of the Food and Agricultural Code, relating to food and agriculture.

**Senate Bill 966:** By Senator Wiener (Coauthors: Assembly Members Cristina Garcia and Rubio)—An act to amend Section 10295 of the Public Contract Code, and to add Article 8 (commencing with Section 13558) to Chapter 7 of Division 7 of the Water Code, relating to water quality.

**Senate Bill 967:** By Senator Berryhill—An act to amend Section 4000 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to mental health.

**Senate Bill 968:** By Senator Pan—An act to add Section 66027.7 to the Education Code, relating to postsecondary education.

**Senate Bill 969:** By Senator Dodd (Coauthor: Assembly Member Aguiar-Curry)—An act to amend Section 19891 of, and to add Section 19892 to, the Health and Safety Code, relating to automatic garage door openers.



**Senate Bill 970:** By Senator Atkins (Principal coauthor: Assembly Member Santiago) (Coauthors: Senators Bates and Nguyen) (Coauthor: Assembly Member Waldron)—An act to add Section 12950.3 to the Government Code, relating to employment.

**Senate Bill 971:** By Senator Nguyen—An act to amend Section 853.85 of the Penal Code, relating to crimes.

The following measure was offered and referred to the Committee on Rules:

**Senate Joint Resolution 18:** By Senator Hueso—Relative to the federal Tax Cuts and Jobs Act.
