Earlier this evening I raised some concerns about the process that has been utilized for this year’s Budget and specifically this Budget Conference Committee.

I would like to read for you Joint Rule 29.5 subsection (c) in its entirety:

(c) A committee on conference of the Budget Bill may consider only differences between the Assembly version of the Budget Bill as passed by the Assembly and the Senate version of the Budget Bill as passed by the Senate, and may not approve any item of expenditure or control that exceeds that contained in one of the two versions before the conference committee.

On May 25, the Senate voted to waive Joint Rules 28, 28.1 and 29 as they relate to the Committee on Conference concerning SB 840. That motion passed 35–0.

It is notable that Joint Rule 29.5 was not waived.

Given the specificity of Joint Rule 29.5 subsection (c), how have we been able to proceed with many of the items that have been before us this evening?

We intend to ask for clarification from the Senate and Legislative Counsel.
