Dear Ms. Contreras: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the unprecedented nature of the 2020 Legislative Calendar, the Rules Committee has decided to have all measures heard by only one policy committee. Because many bills scheduled for referral would have gone to more than one committee under normal circumstances, those second and/or third committees will not have an opportunity to hear these bills. However, these committees will be given the opportunity to provide input to the committee that will be hearing the bill.

The decision to refer a bill to only one policy committee in no way sets a new precedent as it relates to these referrals or committee jurisdictions as outlined in Senate Rule 12.

Dear Ms. Contreras: Due to this year's COVID-19 pandemic and the unprecedented nature of the 2020 Legislative Calendar, the Rules Committee has decided to have all measures heard by only one policy committee. Because many Senate Bills were referred prior to this decision, it is necessary to alter the referral of those previous double and triple referred bills.
